The council wants to know what you think about life in Shaftesbury ward.

Whether it's services like recycling, street cleaning, parking, education and housing where the council has a direct responsibility - or other areas like policing, public transport and the NHS - we want to make sure that we understand your priorities for your community.

The meeting will be chaired by deputy leader of the council and Shaftesbury ward councillor, Jonathan Cook. Your other two ward councillors James Cousins and Guy Senior will also be present along with leader of the opposition, Rex Osborn and senior managers from the main council services.



Boris Bikes The Barclay's Cycle Hire scheme, commonly known as Boris Bikes, will be coming to the ward later this year after the council agreed an extension of the popular bike sharing scheme with the Mayor of London.

Lavender Hill police station The Mayor's police and crime plan proposes a major strengthening of neighbourhood policing, with more police officers on the beat – and that Lavender Hill police station will be open 24 hours, 7 days a week.

Crossrail 2 for Clapham Junction The capital's business leaders have said that the next stage of Crossrail from North East to South West London should go through Clapham Junction. The council has been calling for, and will continue to campaign for, 'Crossrail 2' to run via the station.

Standing up for local residents Local councillors have been working with residents near to Clapham Junction to help alleviate problems – like parking and night-time disorder – that come with living near a busy town centre. If you have any issues with which we can help, get in touch.

Clapham Junction exemplar Long running works to Lavender Hill have been completed, making the area much more pleasant and friendly to pedestrians and improving traffic flow for drivers and public transport users.

New London Overground Service The new London Overground link from Clapham Junction to Canada Water opened in December, providing easy access to East London. It is already being used by more than one million passengers a month.

Looking out for Lavender Hill Shaftesbury Ward councillors are keeping a close eye on Lavender Hill – recently seeing a troublesome bar close after a licensing review. Councillors are also working with the Town Centre Manager to help improve the roads, businesses and shops.

Library plan The council has awarded a new library contract to Greenwich Leisure Ltd, a charitable social enterprise that will maintain and enhance the current high quality service. GLL takes over management and operation at all of the borough's libraries – none of which are closing – on April 2 following an extensive IT upgrade.
